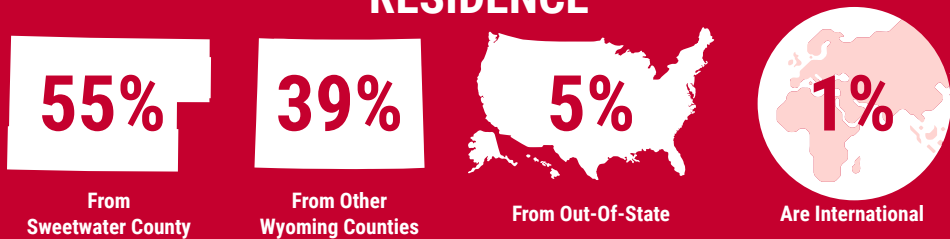

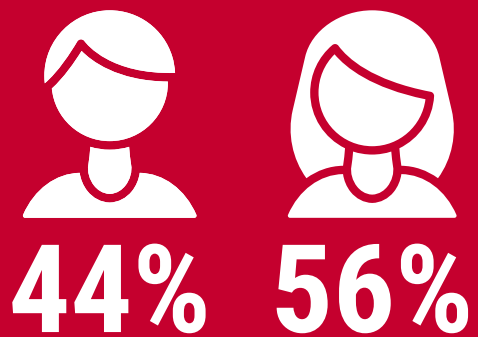


HOUSING OCCUPANCY
