Student Services – Athletics Annual Board Report 2020-2021 Mission/Goals/Annual Objectives “Good People, Good Students, Good Athletes in that order!”

Academic Highlights from 2020-21:

- 35 All-Region Academic Honors and 20 NJCAA All-American Academic Honors
- Women’s Soccer – 3.38 for 18 athletes
- Women’s Basketball – 3.27 for 12 athletes
- Volleyball – 3.23 for 12 athletes
- Wrestling – 3.19 for 26 athletes
- Men’s Basketball – 2.60 for 16 athletes

Academic Initiatives are well-established, notifying instructors of team absences and doing progress reports. Covid changed our approach but we still had mandatory study hours. We also work very closely with the Peer Tutor Center, Math Lab, BIS Lab and Hay Library to create additional resources for student-athletes.

Booster Club Highlights from 2020-2021: Booster membership dollars and donations received for this past year were over \$54,000 even in a Covid year.

Community Service Highlights from 2020-2021:

- 1) Even during COVID, we still managed to do an amazing amount of community service: we helped at the FOOD Bank, with Sodexo-run events on campus, and helped move over a dozen groups.
- 2) Coaches & Lu Sweet speak at Kiwanis and on the radio several times, Lu still writes for the Rocket Miner and the Green River Star. Additionally, she spends an hour or more a week live on KREO.

Athletic Highlights from 2020-2021: (Covid testing 1-2 times per week and still competing!!!)

- Wrestling –7-2nd place finish at Nationals, 10 All-Americans, 10 District Champions, Coach Art Castillo named Rocky Mountain District Coach of the Year & NJCAA Coach of the Year.
- Women’s Soccer –8-5-2 Advanced to District Championship and being Nationally ranked 4 of 9 weeks.
- Men’s Basketball – 16-6 overall record, and advancing to the semi-finals of Region IX Tournament play
- Women’s Basketball – 4-16
- Volleyball – 3-14
