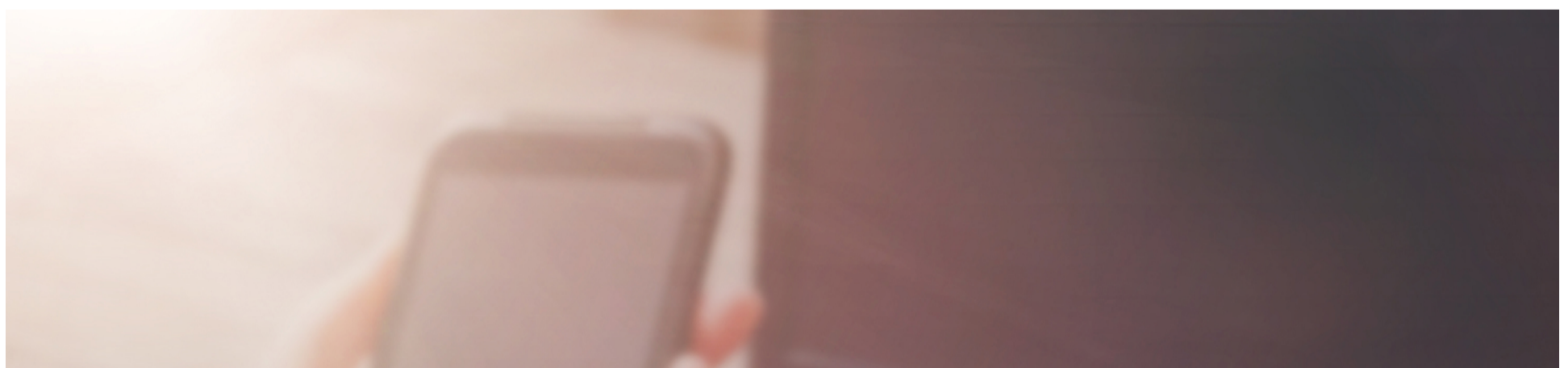


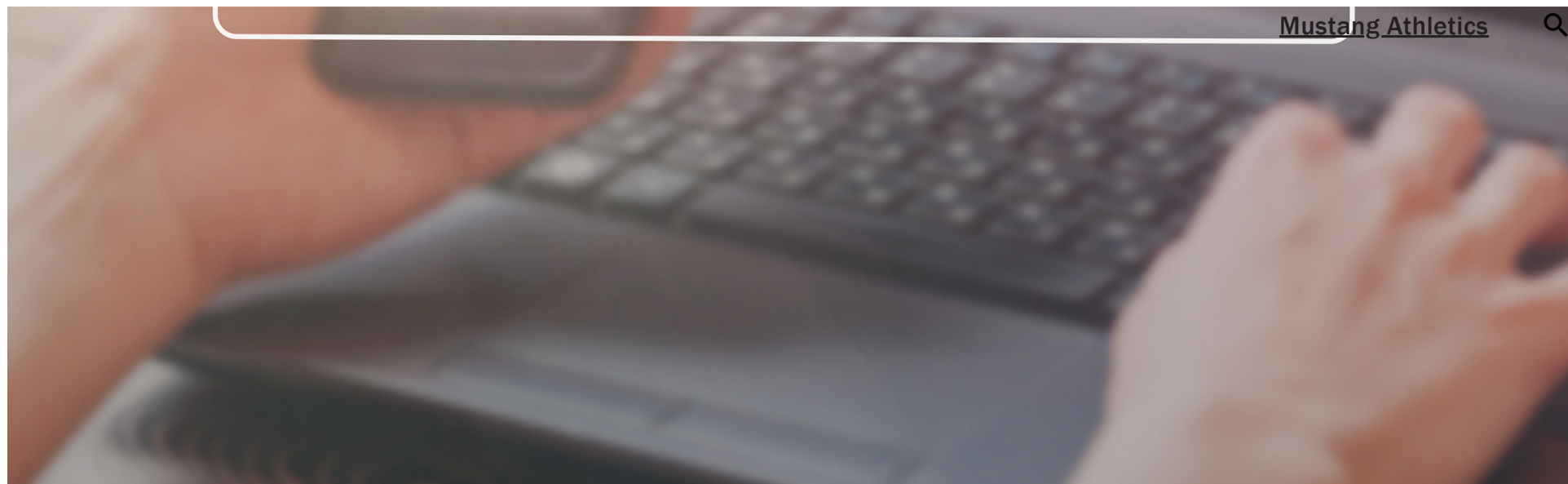
Financial Aid

Now it is time to apply for [scholarships](#), complete our [general scholarship application](#) to be considered for all Institutional and Civic Grants. *For Wyoming high school graduates, remember to [apply for the Hathaway scholarship](#) before July 31st. Hathaway cannot be awarded until this application is completed.

Once you have been accepted for admission and have submitted your FAFSA, begin checking your My Western Account.

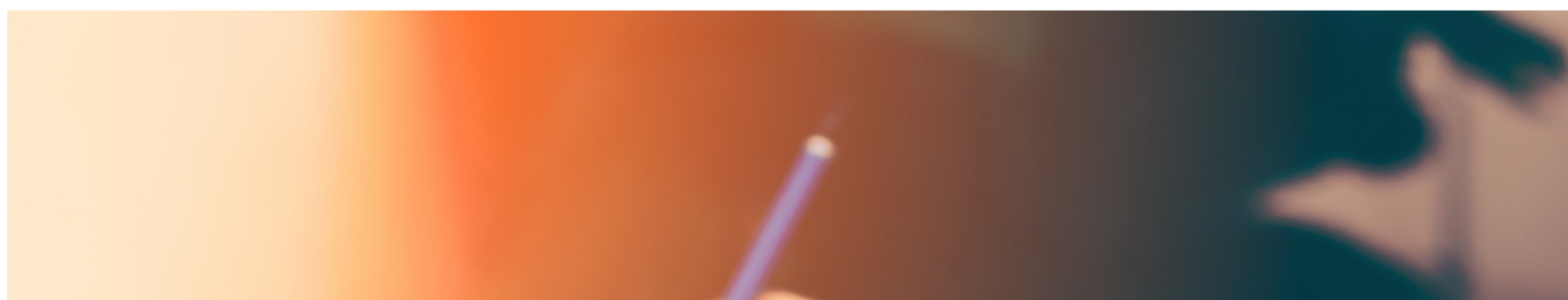
