Background

The Human Resources Office conducted a national search commencing in July 2021, to fill the position of Dean of Enrollment Management. The Human Resources Office received thirteen completed applications for this position, and the Professional Standards Board conducted seven virtual interviews and four on-campus interviews. The Professional Standards Board recommends that Eric Fry be offered the position of Dean of Enrollment Management.

Status

Mr. Fry holds a Master of Education in Counseling and Higher Education Leadership and a Bachelor of Arts in History, both from the University of Montevallo in Montevallo, Alabama, and an Associate's in Anthropology from American River Community College in Sacramento, California. Mr. Fry's experience includes serving as Managing Director for Ole Miss International in Oxford, Mississippi, from 12/2018 to 10/2020; as Executive Director with INTO University Partnerships (Marshall University and Queen's University Belfast) from 04/2013 to 10/2018; as Consulting Lead for King Abdullah University of Science and Technology in Thuwal, Saudi Arabia from 02/2012 to 02/2013; as Director of Admissions and Student Affairs for the University of Illinois, Rockford Campus from 01/2010 to 01/2012; as Director of Student Affairs for Weill Cornell Medical College in Ar-Rayyan, Qatar from 01/2006 to 01/2010; and as Safe School Program Manager for Sacramento City and San Juan Unified School Districts in California from 2001 to 2006.
