

# Placement Information: English and United States Government

Students should discuss scores with their advisor to ensure proper placement has been met.

Placement test scores must be received and entered in the student file prior to course registration.

English placement at WWCC can be determined by:

- Reading & English ACT scores (within the past 3 years) or
- Reading & Writing Scores on the McCann College Success Exam or
- Previously earned college credit (subject to transcript evaluation)



**Placement is based on ACT or McCann - tests cannot be combined.**

Students who are not placed into college-level coursework via ACT scores (or previously earned college credit) should take the McCann Exam for placement.
